Position Summary: Under the supervision of the Thrift Store Manager, the Baler is responsible for operating the baling machine, loading pallets onto and off of trailers, and helping with any other warehouse work as needed.

Reports to: Thrift Store Manager

Exempt/ Non Exempt: Non Exempt

Required: Must be willing to sign the Gospel Mission Statement of Faith; and Marriage and Sexuality Statement, and must be a member of a local Bible believing church.

Position Responsibilities:

1. Operating the baling machine to bind clothing received from the Donation Center.
2. Loads pallets into trailer when bales are finished.
3. Load bales onto semi trailer when truck comes to pick up loads of bales.
4. Receives any clothing donations that come in from Donation Center.
5. Maintains a clean and safe environment.

2. Required: Previous experience operating a forklift
3. Preferred: Previous experience working in a warehouse
